Research Databases

Agricola 1970+

<http://www.lib.uconn.edu/> (UConn Libraries homepage) → All Databases → By Database Name → *Agricola*

Covers all aspects of agriculture and allied disciplines, including animal and veterinary sciences, entomology, plant sciences, forestry, aquaculture and fisheries, farming and farming systems, agricultural economics, extension and education, food and human nutrition, and earth and environmental sciences. Covers journals, books, reports, etc.

CAB Direct 1973+

The most comprehensive coverage of agriculture and allied disciplines (see list for *Agricola*), including nutrition, leisure and tourism. More international coverage than *Agricola*, both sources and geography. Best online resource for veterinary coverage. Covers journals, books, conferences, etc.

Web of Science 1994+

Multidisciplinary bibliographic database that indexes and abstracts journals in the sciences, social sciences, arts, and humanities. Restrict searching to *Science Citation Index* component for most relevant results.

AGRIS International 1975+

Covers general agriculture, extension, administration and legislation, economics, development, and rural sociology, plant production, forestry, animal production, aquatic sciences and fisheries, machinery and buildings, natural resources, food science, home economics, human nutrition, and pollution. International coverage. Covers journals, books, reports, etc.

BIOSIS Previews 1969+

General biology, botany, molecular biology, zoology, microbiology, ecology and evolution. Multidisciplinary overlap includes experimental, clinical and veterinary medicine, biotechnology and genetics, agriculture and nutrition, biochemistry, pharmacology and public health.

PubMed – MEDLINE through National Library of Medicine 1950+

PubMed provides access to MEDLINE, the National Library of Medicine's premier bibliographic database covering the medical sciences, including much of interest to animal science. Coverage from more than 4,500 biomedical journals published in the United States and 70 other countries.

LexisNexis News 1980s+

SCOPUS 1966+

SCOPUS is the world's largest journal indexing and abstracting database with 27 million records covering articles from 14,000 peer-reviewed titles from more than 4,000 international publishers in scientific, medical, technical and social science fields.
